### **Comprehensive response to domestic violence**

- Intervention, Treatment & Services
- Effective System Response (Accountability)
- Raise Awareness & Reduce Risk
- Promote Healthy Norms and Behaviors

### **Prevention:** Promote Healthy Norms and Behaviors

- *Primary Prevention:* a **systematic** process that **promotes** healthy **environments** and behaviors and reduces the likelihood of an incident, condition, or injury **before** it occurs in the first place (from Prevention Institute, [www.preventioninstitute.org](http://www.preventioninstitute.org))
  - Primary: Before violence takes place (upfront)
  - Secondary: Immediate responses (in the thick)
  - Tertiary: Long term responses (aftermath)
